
The Board interviewed all sixteen applicants over a three day period from January 31 – February 2, 2012. At the conclusion of the interviews, Mondy Taylor was approved as our newest Board member. Mrs. Taylor will take the oath of office at the Board meeting on Thursday, February 9, 2012, 6:30 p.m. at the District Education Center located at 6061 East Avenue in Etiwanda.

Mrs. Taylor has previously served as an elected member of the Board of Trustees. Mondy was elected in 1991 and served until 2006 when her family relocated to Nevada. In 2011, Mondy's family moved back in to our District, residing in the city of Fontana. Mondy was a member of the Board governance team that made many important decisions which allowed our District to maintain the quality of our instructional program during a period of explosive growth in the community. The District constructed and opened eleven schools during Mondy's first tenure on the Board as enrollment increased from 3,000 students to over 12,000 students. During this time the Board also allocated funding for the District's first technology plan, insuring access to instructional technology tools for all students.




